MADURAI: Water level in the Periyar dam on Friday stood at 132.40 feet (full level 136 feet) with an inflow of 644 cusecs and a discharge of 1.746 cusecs. The level in the Vaigai dam was 59.09 feet (71 feet) with an inflow of 1.639 cusecs and a discharge of 3,673 cusecs. The combined Periyar credit stood at 6,954 mcft. Shanmuganadi recorded 7 mm of rainfall followed by Manjalar dam and Sothuparai 3 mm each, Veerapandi 2, Peranai 1.3, Vaigai dam 1 and Tekkadi 0.5 mm.

It should be as simple as learning mother tongue: K. Chellappan

SIVAGANGA: K. Chellappan, former Director, State Institute of English, Chennai, has emphasised the need for making the language education, including English, as simple as learning the mother tongue.

Inaugurating a two-day international conference on Emerging trends in language and literature,' organised by the Department of English and Foreign Languages at Alagappa University in Karaikudi on Friday, he said the current pattern of systematic and structural English teaching right from the grammar level had not so far yielded the expected results.

The inefficiency of the system, though it was an organised one, had been felt by academicians.

"Repetition kills the creploring the language through a practical manner," he said.
